



Downtown De Pere Farmers Market Guidelines and Requirements

Location George Street Plaza (George Street between Broadway and Wisconsin Street)

Cost One 10' x 10' Stall - \$150 | Two 10' x 10' Stalls - \$250 | Daily Stall - \$25

General Guidelines

- Fill out the online application and submit electronically by March 15, 2021 (see link below).
- Mail all required forms and payment, postmarked by March 22, 2021. Checks will be deposited once accepted to the market. Vendor fees are nonrefundable after April 23, 2021.
- Acceptance letters will be sent by April 16, 2021.
- Stall numbers and placement will be given at the first market of the season.
- Vendors may not sublet their space or allow another vendor to sell in their booth.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting any applicable sales tax (if applicable).
- All legal-for-trade scales should be approved by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture.
- Vendors are responsible for all required licenses, permits and corresponding fees.

Vendor Rules and Regulations

Produce Vendor criteria for uncut vegetables, fruits and cut flowers.

- Must be locally grown (except peaches and blueberries) and cultivated by vendor.
- Vendor must own or lease the property where the produce is grown.
- Buying, reselling, and sharing of produce amongst vendors is prohibited.
- Organic vendors must have proof of certification.
- If selling products by weight, an approved scale is required.

Protein & Dairy Vendor criteria for meat, poultry, fish, eggs and cheese.

- Must be locally produced by vendor.
- Vendor must own or lease the property where the protein and dairy is produced.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
- Organic vendors must have proof of certification.
- If selling products by weight, an approved scale is required.

Processed Food Vendor criteria for prepackaged foods.

- All foods must be processed by vendor.
- Product must be made in a licensed and inspected establishment.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
- If selling products by weight, an approved scale is required.

Prepared Food Vendor criteria for foods prepared on-site.

- Food sold must be prepared on-site by the vendor.
- Only one vendor selling the same type of product will be accepted.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin and a Temporary Restaurant Permit.
- General liability insurance listing Definitely De Pere as additional insured.

Art and Craft Vendor criteria for handcrafted and homemade products.

- Items for sale must be of original design or creation.
- Items for sale must be made by the vendor selling them.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
